
Exmouth ABC has been established since 1947 and this year will be celebrate its 70<sup>th</sup> year of amateur boxing under the auspices of the Amateur Boxing Association (ABA).

The club is a not for profit club holding regular training sessions for competitive boxers, both male and female aged 10 and upwards. It also holds regular women's fitness sessions for girls and ladies of all ages. At the present time the club has ten competing boxers. Many of the other young boxers are well on their way to competitive bouts. The ladies fitness sessions have grown significantly in popularity and has a regular attendance of upwards of fifteen ladies at each session.

The club is run solely by volunteers with three qualified coaches and one assistant coach for the main boxing session with the ladies fitness run by two female sports instructors.

The administration of the club is also run by volunteers; the committee consists of a chairman, treasurer, secretary, child welfare officer, a boxers' representative (to provide feedback from the boxers perspective) and other members who assist with the general upkeep of the club. Many of these positions are held by people who both use the gym for boxing / fitness and to contribute at committee meetings.

The club is successful in terms of achievement and popularity and, over the years, has produced many great boxers. New life has been breathed into the club providing different ways to impact on young people's lives and their ability to engage and take part in sport. The character of the club helps it understand the lives of young people, the barriers they face and how it can adapt and ensure sport for good is accessible to everyone. The club finds itself busier than ever with more and more young people hoping to box. To continue its success, the club is hopeful it can acquire some funding and sponsorship to provide competition kit. The youngsters will wear the kit with pride when representing their club and their community.
